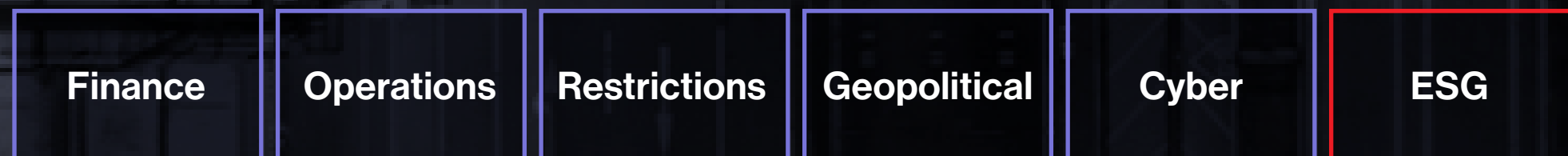

Average revenue loss of UK organisations due to supply chain disruption

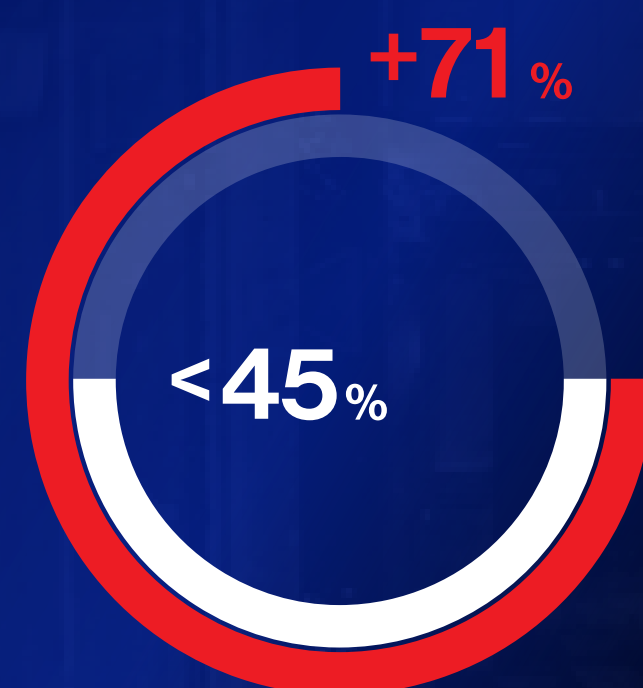


Impact spread evenly across multiple event types:



ESG disruptions cost UK companies an average of **£36M** in revenue losses

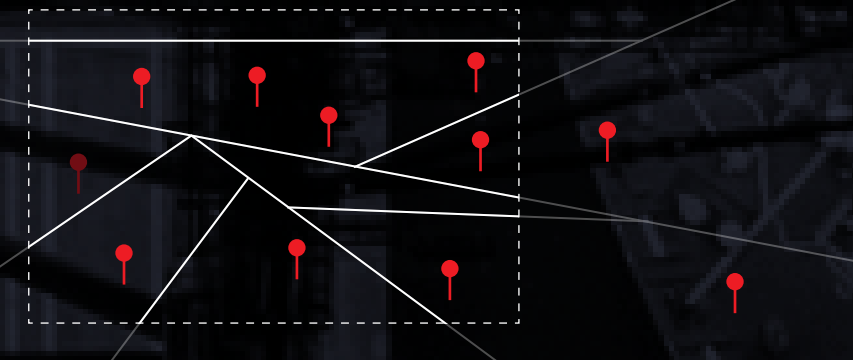
## Organisational Impact



71% of organisations experience disruptions beyond Tier 2.  
<45% know when they occur.



## Concentration Risk



89% of UK organisations agree suppliers are concentrated too heavily in various geographies



UK companies plan to reshore 49% of their supply chains within 3 years



Of suppliers are typically evaluated as part of organisational risk analysis

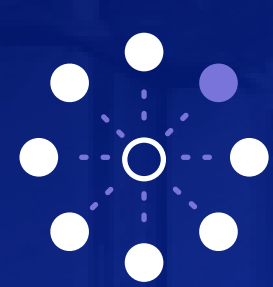

# Geopolitical Impact

## Risk Miscalculation

Before Russia invaded Ukraine only 33% of UK organisations considered geopolitical risk “important”. After, over 42% did. Organisations aren’t monitoring important risks until it’s too late.



3/4 agree they need to improve information sharing and collaboration with internal partners (**86%**) and external suppliers (**88%**)
